DIRECTIONS TO MILLER'S SPORTFISHING DOCK

Miller's Sportfishing is located within the Nautical Mile on Jefferson Avenue just south of Ten Mile Road. The launch point for all trips is Michigan Harbor / Colony Marine, 24600 Jefferson, St. Clair Shores, MI 48080. We are less than a one-hour drive from most Detroit suburbs. You can expect some of the finest angling action that anyone could experience on the world-renowned and beautiful Lake St. Clair, with its bragging-size Muskies and quality Walleye production. *All muskies are catch and release.*

Please call Captain Don (734-395-8820) when you get to the electronic gate inside the marina.

- From west of Detroit . . .

Take I-94 eastbound to the 10 Mile Road exit, and get off at the ramp. When you reach the top of the hill, turn right on 10 Mile Road. Proceed approximately two miles all the way to Jefferson Avenue. Turn right at Jefferson and go 1/4 mile; then turn left at Michigan Harbor / Colony Marine. Proceed along the long khaki-colored pole barns on the right hand side until they end. Turn right and go approximately 100 yards to the cyclone fence, then turn left. **There is an electronic gate here—please call Captain Don (734-395-8820) to proceed to well #56.** The *Muskie Hunter* is located on the left side, near the end of the first bay of boats before you get to the lake.

- From Port Huron . . .

Take I-94 westbound to the 10 Mile Road exit, and get off at the ramp. When you reach the top of the hill, turn left on 10 Mile Road. Proceed approximately two miles all the way to Jefferson Avenue. Turn right onto Jefferson Avenue, and go 1/4 mile; then turn left at Michigan Harbor / Colony Marine. Proceed along the long khaki-colored pole barns on the right hand side until they end. Turn right and go approximately 100 yards to the cyclone fence, then turn left. **There is an electronic gate here—please call Captain Don (734-395-8820) to proceed to well #56.** The *Muskie Hunter* is located on the left side, near the end of the first bay of boats before you get to the lake.
